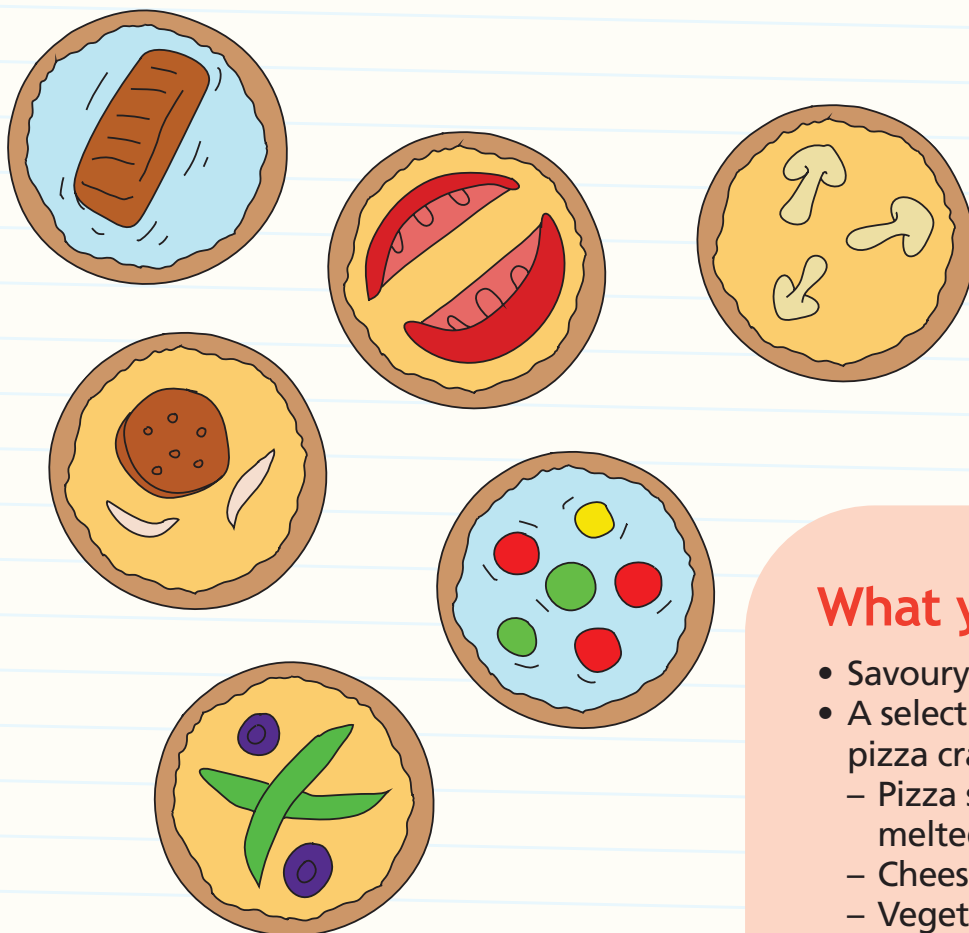


# Pizza party

## What you'll need

- Savoury crackers, 2 per girl
- A selection of toppings for the pizza crackers, such as:
  - Pizza sauce (tomato puree or melted chocolate)
  - Cheese
  - Vegetables
  - Fruit
  - Sweets

## Note to leader

This activity suggests making pizza with crackers, but you could create paper pizza slices or use real pizza if you have the facilities. Make sure to check for allergies and dietary requirements when using food.

Cheesy or chocolatey pizza? Create your dream slice and discover what you do and don't have in common with other Rainbows in your unit.

## What to do

**1** Raise your hand if pizza is one of your favourite foods. If your hand's up, tell everyone one thing you love about pizza. Is it the tasty toppings or the gooey cheese?

**2** What would be on your dream pizza? Would it be covered in tasty vegetables like peppers and onions, or would it be a chocolate pizza covered in marshmallows?

**3** Let's make some dreamy pizza slices! Pick up a cracker, choose a base and take some toppings you love.

**4** Once everyone's created their dream pizza slices, come together in a big circle. Take turns showing your slice and telling everyone why it's the yummiest in the world. Keep going until everyone's had a turn.

**5** Now, put your pizza slice down in front of you. Looking at everyone else's, what do you notice? Some of the slices might be the same, but some might be very different. That's what makes every slice in your Rainbows' pizza unique!

**6** Everyone at Rainbows has things that make them unique. Let's take some time to celebrate our differences! Do you have any hobbies? Do you all go to the same school? Our personalities and cultures are different too. Take turns to jump into the middle of your circle and say something that makes you different. After each one, all do a big cheer!

**7** Once everyone's celebrated your uniqueness, it's time to eat your pizza slice – yum!
